

## **NOTICE TO MARINERS N°.05 - 2018**

## Newhaven Harbour Speed Limits

Mariners are reminded that the maximum speed limit in Newhaven Harbour anywhere north of the West Pier Signal Station is **5 Knots.** 

An increasing number of vessels of all types are exceeding this limit and causing distress to other users and damage to other vessels.

This will not be tolerated, and the Harbour Authority will now be actively seeking prosecution of offending vessels. You have been warned. No further warnings will be given.

You are also requested to have consideration for other port users and their vessels by going even slower past moored vessels and vessels smaller than yours. This is common courtesy and seamanlike. The 5 knots limit is a **maximum** speed limit - **you can go slower.** 

Masters and others in charge of craft are warned to navigate with caution at all times within the Harbour Limits and pay strict attention to directions issued to them by Newhaven Port Control, who act with the delegated authority of the Harbour Master.
