

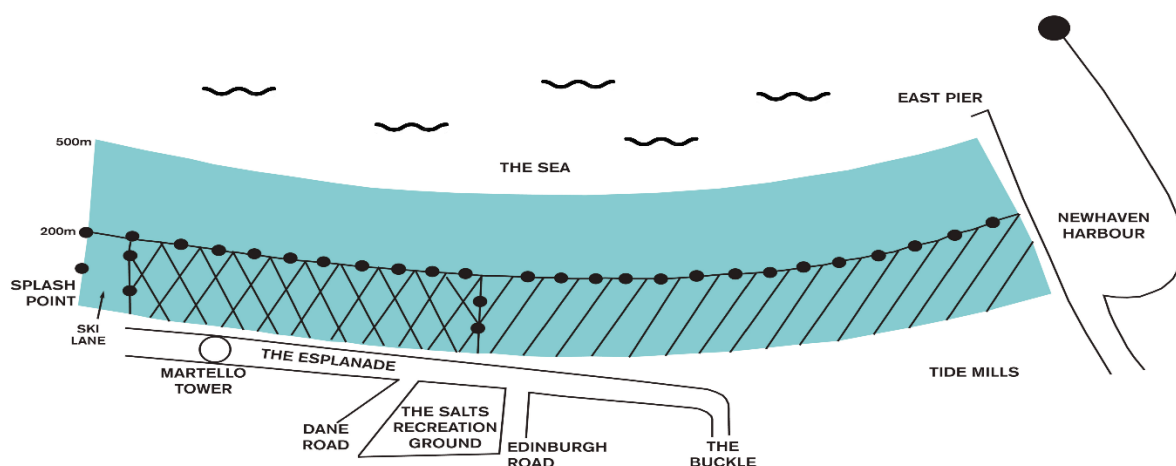
NOTICE TO MARINERS N°.06 - 2018





Seaford Bay Seasonal Marker Buoys

Mariners are reminded that the yellow buoys positioned within Seaford Bay for the summer season are there for a reason as per the Byelaws below.

They are not to be used for mooring up to; or to be used as a slalom course for speedboats and jet-skis; or to be otherwise interfered with.
