

NOTICE TO MARINERS N°. 17 – 2024

Dredging Campaign Newhaven Marina – November/December 2024

Mariners are advised that ML Dredging Ltd will be carrying out dredging operations within Newhaven Marina commencing on approximately the 19th November 2024. The works are expected to take up to 6 weeks. All work is subject to the weather conditions.

The dredging will be carried out by the Backhoe dredger WITTON II which will be permanently positioned within the confines of the Marina throughout the operation. The vessel will be restricted in her ability to manoeuvre and all vessels must keep clear of her. The vessel will exhibit lights and shapes in accordance with the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea and will be maintaining a listening watch on VHF channel 12.

Self-propelled split hopper barge SPLIT THREE will be transporting the spoil material from the Marina to the disposal ground. The works will involve frequent passages from the Harbour to the Disposal Ground, situated approximately 1 mile south of Newhaven Breakwater Lighthouse, as indicated on nautical charts. These vessels will also be maintaining a listening watch on VHF channel 12.

Masters and others in charge of craft are warned to navigate with caution and pay strict attention to information and directions issued to them by Newhaven Port Control. Call sign **"Newhaven Radio" - VHF Channel 12**. Tel. 01273 612926.
